2. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class.
3. Judging will take place Thursday after $6: 00$ p.m.
4. All flowers must be grown, selected, and arranged by the exhibitor. Wildflowers do not have to be grown by exhibitors.
5. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts requires the exhibit be entered under the individual's name. The farm name may be listed second. Please no advertising.
6. Whenever possible, please name the flower variety.
7. Endangered species must not be used.
8. Containers are to be furnished by the exhibitor and must have a name on the bottom.
9. Houseplant must be owned for at least 6 months.

- Uniformity - 20\%
- Proper Size and Shape - 20\%
- Free of Blemishes - 20\%
- Overall Quality - 30\%
- Follow Entrance Directions - 10\%
